Childhood Advisory Council – Central Coast Conference Committee:

The committee members, represent many facets of the early education community, met regularly to coordinate and develop the annual conference. The Central Coast Conference was held at Cabrillo College on Saturday, October 6th and was attended by over 200 early educators, some from surrounding counties. Attendees select workshops from a wide variety topics that focused on Building Resilience in Children. The conference also included a mid-morning snack and exhibits. The committee will take a well-deserved hiatus until February 2019.

Subsidized Programs Consortium Committee:

The Subsidized Programs Consortium Committee continues to focus on revising and completing the AB 300 Individualized Subsidy Child Care Pilot Plan for our county. The committee also discusses new legislation, streamlining program administration protocols and new child care expansion funding that was recently released by the state. This committee serves as the Advisory Board for the Early Education Career Incentive Program (AB 212) and CA Transitional Kindergarten Stipend programs. They advise the CAC Coordinator on training topics and program needs that would best support their teaching staff.
