I. Early Education Career Incentive Program (EECIP) Update (Formerly, the AB 212 Staff Retention and Professional Development Program).

- Coordinator collaborated with CDRC, Bridge Program to present the *Trauma Basics* training on Saturday, November 4th to state funded child care teachers.
- Coordinator collaborated with *CA Preschool Instructional Network (CPIN)* to present *Best Practices for Planning Curriculum for Young Children: Family Partnership and Culture* training on Saturday, November 17th for state funded child care teachers.
- Coordinator collaborated with WestEd to present *the CA Teaching Pyramids: Promoting Children's Success: Revisiting the CA CSEFEL Teaching Pyramid*, Saturday, December 1st for state funded child care teachers.

II. Childhood Advisory Council – Central Coast Conference

- Coordinator and subcommittee members hosted the Central Coast Conference, on Saturday, October 6th in Aptos. The conference theme was *Building Resilience in Children*.
