- I. Early Care, Education and After-School Care Master Plan**
 - The CAC Master Plan was approved by the County Superintendent of Schools on Monday, June 18th and by the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors on Tuesday, June 26th. The Plan was submitted to the State on Tuesday, June 26th.

- II. AB 212 Staff Retention and Professional Development Update**
 - Coordinator hosted the Trauma Informed Systems for Administrators training on Wednesday, September 5th. Administrators were invited to join phase two of the TIS system. Participating programs will receive In depth training and engage in learning circles to support to full implementation of the TIS program.

- III. AB 300 (Caballero) Individualized Child Care Subsidy Pilot Plan Update**
 - Coordinator is working with Mission Analytics Group and the State to reformat the plan using the new template designed by the State.

- IV. Childhood Advisory Council Central Coast Conference**
 - Coordinator is working with early education stakeholders to coordinate the Central Coast Conference that will be held on Saturday, October 6th from 8:00 – 1:00 pm at Cabrillo College.

- V. Countywide Professional Development Calendar**
 - Coordinator developed a countywide professional development calendar for the early care and education community. Trainings listed focus on a variety of topics intended to support state funded child care program staff and family child care providers. Trainings on the calendar are sponsored by QRIS/Quality Counts Santa Cruz County, Child Development Resource Center and Childhood Advisory Council's AB 212 program.
