TK Enrollment Schedule:

- In the 2022-23 school year, a child who will have their fifth birthday between September 2 and February 2 shall be admitted to a TK program maintained by the school district or charter school
- In the 2023-24 school year, a child who will have their fifth birthday between September 2 and April 2 shall be admitted to a TK program maintained by the school district or charter school
- In the 2024–25 school year, a child who will have their fifth birthday between September 2 and June 2 shall be admitted to a TK program maintained by the school district or charter school
- In the 2025–26 school year, and in each school year thereafter, a child who will have their fourth birthday by September 1 shall be admitted to a TK program maintained by the school district or charter school
