Re: PCR vs Antigen testing. But PH, COE, and CDPH recommend using antigen tests, not PCR tests, for returning to a site (school/childcare) after a person has been positive, and in order to exit isolation and return to their school or childcare. A negative antigen test is used here to allow the positive person back to work/childcare/school, not a PCR, as people can continue testing positive on a PCR for up to 3 months, so that is why an antigen test is used instead.
