	 A.Anderson: Always have 10% as a guideline, hiring teachers is a challenge L.Mendoza: Currently below enrollment Donna: under 7% enrolled with needs L.Sandoval: Clarification- Current percent is 5%, will be at 7 ½ % by July 1, 2025, then to 10% as of July 1, 2026 Program updates: L.Mendoza: current enrollment is 30 students, need substitutes L.Sandoval: need staff, WRAP program at 3 sites, 10 TK sites with 3 full day, Freedom center is back open but lack of staff, working on outreach to get high schoolers interested in ECE. A.Anderson: Need staff, delayed site openings, will be opening two toddler centers soon. C.Morales: Lack of teachers, renovating Freedom center, had a review last week and commended on transportation and family assistance. Currently transporting 25 kids to speech therapy each week. Getting ready and planning Parent Night event next week. L.Orosco: Have 40 FCC providers, 6 interested in joining, holding trainings for FCC's. Families are unable to get service needs met. Donna: AM programs are full at 2 sites, PM's have some space. Considering adding TKers to the PM space. Full day program is full with a waitlist.
