Child Care Expansion Priorities Report for 2015

The Local Planning Council (CCPC) is required to identify local priorities for the distribution of new State and Federal child and preschool funding. The priorities for new funding are determined by zip code, eligibility, current enrollment and unmet need. In addition, each county can determine a local priority ranking using relevant local community information. (See attached Santa Cruz County Combined Zip Code Priorities for 2015 report). The completed the report was reviewed by the Executive Committee and the Subsidized Programs Consortium Committee with the recommendation to send last year's priority rankings to the State. The report will be submitted by Friday, May 29th with approval by the Council.
