I. AB 212 Staff Retention and Professional Development Program

- AB 212 Advisory Committee (Subsidized Programs Consortium Members) identified training topics that will increase staff confidence and knowledge. Trainings will focus on:
 - Desired Results Developmental Program (DRDPtech and Portfolio App)
 - Social and Emotional Foundations for Early Learning (CSEFEL)
 - CPIN Preschool Learning Foundations, Volume 3 – Science, Social Science and History.
- Coordinator is collaborating with Race to the Top to offer Desired Results Developmental Program (DRDP) 2015 training on Saturday, September 12th.

II. California Transitional Kindergarten Stipend Program (CTKS)

- Coordinator met with CTKS Ad hoc Committee to learn about program requirements, review the draft program application, and make recommendations. New committee members were identified and a recruitment plan was agreed upon.
